

DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH

From Chicago take I-57 South to I-72. Take I-72 East about 1 mile to Mattis Ave. Turn right and proceed about 2 1/2 miles to Kirby Ave. Turn left on Kirby and continue for 3 miles to Fourth St. Turn right on Fourth and then immediately right again into the arena service drive.

FROM THE SOUTH

Take I-57 North to I-72. Take I-72 East about 1 mile to Mattis Ave. Turn right and proceed about 2 1/2 miles to Kirby Ave. Turn left on Kirby and continue for 3 miles to Fourth St. Turn right on Fourth and then immediately right again into the arena service drive.

FROM THE WEST

Take I-74 East to Lincoln Ave. exit. Exit South on Lincoln Ave. and proceed approximately 3 miles to Florida Ave. Turn right on Florida Ave. and continue 3/4 of a mile to Fourth St. Turn left on Fourth and then immediately right again into the arena service drive.

FROM THE EAST

Take I-74 West to Lincoln Ave. exit. Exit South on Lincoln Ave. and proceed approximately 3 miles to Florida Ave. Turn right on Florida Ave. and continue 3/4 of a mile to Fourth St. Turn left on Fourth and then immediately right again into the arena service drive.

PARKING

Trucks can be queued in the service road that runs North-South adjacent to the load-in tunnel on the East side of the arena. Busses can be located on either side of the guard house located on the North side of the building. Shore power is available at the bus parking location. The guard house entrance is also the stage door for access throughout the day.



HOUSE EQUIPMENT

Whether it is our StageRight staging and barricade, our in-house forklifts or our own rigging and lighting packages, State Farm Center is equipped to help make your event a successful one. Below is a list of some of the equipment we have in-house.

- StageRight black Techstage (4' x 8' sections)
- StageRight CC500 Blowthru barricade (black)
- Two (2) propane forklifts
- Twelve (12) 3,000 WATT-Strong spotlights throughout the space
- Lift Capacity 6000 & 4850





SAFETY AND PRODUCTION

State Farm Center takes pride in ensuring the safety of all of its guests (both front and back of house). From fire lanes to pyrotechnic regulations, the following are some of the policies the building enforces to maintain a safe environment.

EQUIPMENT/FORK LIFTS

The use of arena equipment, such as the forklifts, can only be operated by individuals certified to use that piece of equipment. All equipment should be operated and stored in a safe fashion.

There are two Hyster fork-trucks available in-house. We have one 6000 lb. lift and one 4850 lb. lift. Both forklifts have a 15' reach.

LOAD-IN ACCESS

Three auto-level truck docks are available underground and indoors with the entrance ramp located on the east side of the building. These docks are approximately 175 feet from the arena floor. Loadin restrictions are: height 9'-6", width 11'-6".

FIRE REGULATIONS

For pyrotechnics, lasers, and open flames, an onsite inspection may be required. That demonstration will be with the chief university public safety officer and times should be coordinated through the building production manager. All pyrotechnicians will need to have proof of the proper licensing with the ATF. Other items that will be required are proof of insurance for the performance date. The University of Illinois Board of Trustees should be named as additionally insured. Insurance certificates should be sent to the State Farm Center business office as far ahead of the performance date as possible.

OSHA

State Farm Center complies with OSHA regulations.

CABLES AND CORDS

Any cable or cord that is in an area on the floor that is accessible to a guest, employee or member of a visiting tour must be covered by a yellow jacket, cable ramp, or some kind of tape in order to minimize a tripping hazard.





RIGGING

Only experienced riggers are permitted on the rigging steel. All riggers are required to use safety cables while rigging.

STAGING

Staging is a portable stage system manufactured by Stage Right Inc. It is adjustable from 4'0''-5'0''in height and can be built in any dimension up to 88'x44' as long as the dimensions are multiples of the 4'x8' panel system. This stage product is certified for uniformly distributed live-load capacity of 4000 pounds per 4' x 8' section (125 pounds per square foot). Each panel is a stress skin design, which means that it will not accept lag screws. There are a dozen solid panels available that can be placed at key locations to provide lagging capability.

LIGHTING EQUIPMENT

There is a variety of in-house lighting equipment available. A FOH bridge position is located about 115' from the proscenium opening. That location has 22 - Source 4 5° instruments powered by 24 - Ik dimmers. These circuits can be run from our ETC Expression console or they can accept DMX signal from the show lighting system.

FOLLOWING SPOTS

There are 12 Strong Xenon Gladiator 3KW spotlights on permanent platforms just above the top row of seats at an elevation of 75' above the floor. They are spaced evenly around the circumference of the arena, which allows for both front and back light positions with any stage placement.

ARENA SOUND

Main Speakers:

For sporting events, the main system consists of 96 active JBL 4887 line array elements and 12 active JBL 4880 subwoofers broken down into 6 clusters for arena seat coverage. Lower arena seat coverage is a bumper hung speaker cluster in the center of the arena/scoreboard with 6 JBL AM-7215.







CENTER STAGE 360 CONFIGURATION TOTAL CAPACITY: 15,888




END STAGE (360) CONFIGURATION TOTAL CAPACITY: 15,700




ENDSTAGE (270) CONFIGURATION TOTAL CAPACITY: 10,765




BROADWAY CONFIGURATION TOTAL CAPACITY: 3,670







THEATER EXPANDED CONFIGURATION TOTAL CAPACITY: 5,717






THEATER EXPANDED CONFIGURATION WITH FLOOR







